THE HOPE TARGET

At Station #8, each shooter gets up to two chances to break the HOPE Target before the regular scored pair.

- It does not affect your score
- Break it and earn one free raffle ticket
- One free ticket per shooter

SUPER SQUAD CHALLENGE

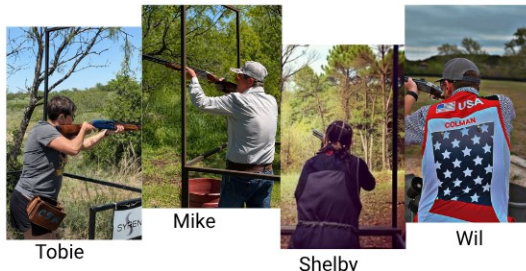
Beat their combined score and your team earns the Champion of HOPE Trophy until next year's event.
